

Rural Development Programmes 2014-2020: Key facts & figures FOCUS AREA 2A: Improving economic performance of all farms, farm restructuring and modernisation

1. Introduction

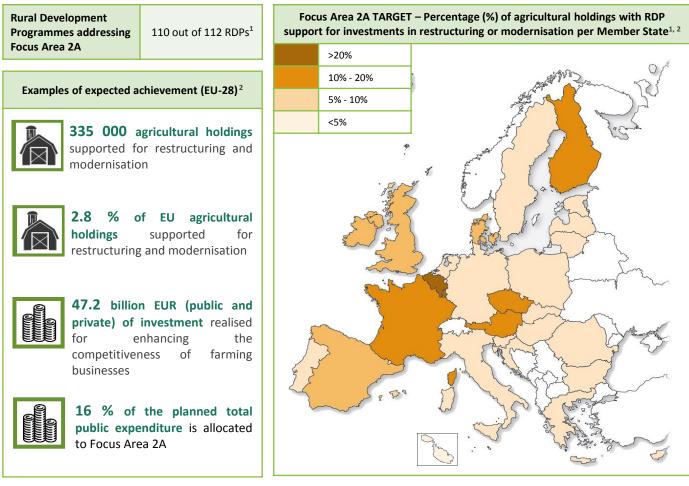
Focus Area (FA) 2A is designed to restore and enhance the competiveness of farms confronted with major challenges such as low and fluctuating prices, and concentration.

Through this focus area, Member States are able to provide farmers with a flexible package of hard investment measures backed up by advice, training, cooperation and knowledge transfer.

The aims are to:

- help farms overcome major structural problems;
- invest in farm equipment and technology which improves their economic viability;
- add value by investing in processing, marketing and product development.

The target is to mobilise 47.2 billion EUR of public and private investment to support 335,000 farms.

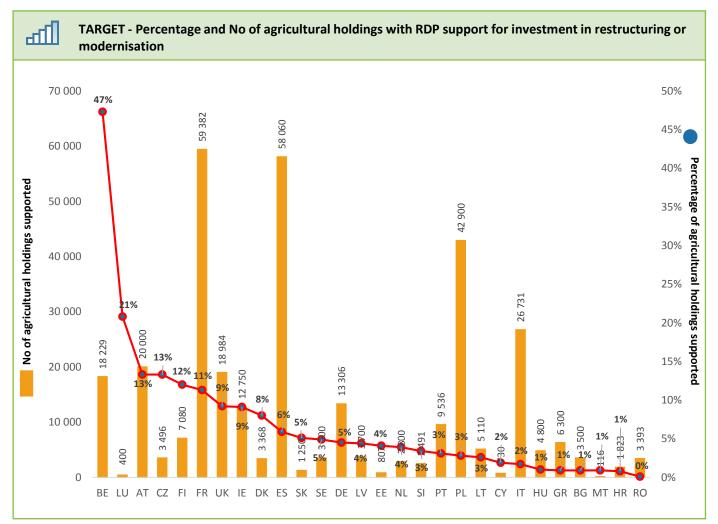

2. Expected achievements

This section provides information on the common target indicator defined for the Focus Area and examples of programme-specific target indicators defined by some RDPs to complement the common targets indicators. Target values in percentage are calculated on the basis of the total number of agricultural holdings covered by the RDPs that activated Focus Area 2A.



In addition to the common targets set at EU level, Member States may set programme specific targets which reflect their particular circumstances. Some examples of these indicators are provided below.

Examples of programme-specific target indicators

- Denmark Number of jobs created by the green transition (excluding Leader): 550 jobs
- Murcia, Spain Area affected by irrigation improvements: 200 ha
- Rhineland-Palatine, Germany Percentage (%) of agricultural land currently structurally developed particularly through land readjustment procedures: **7.8** %
- Romania Percentage (%) of small holdings with RDP support²: 4.1%

² In Romania there are 60 997 small farms (between EUR 8 000 and 11 999 Standard Output).

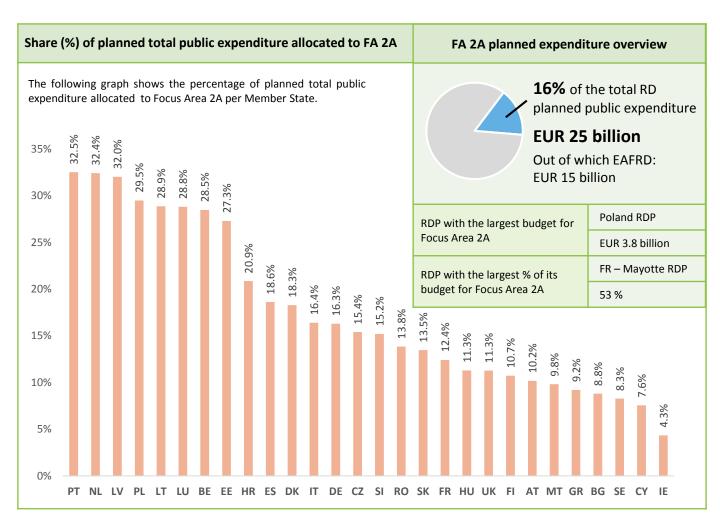

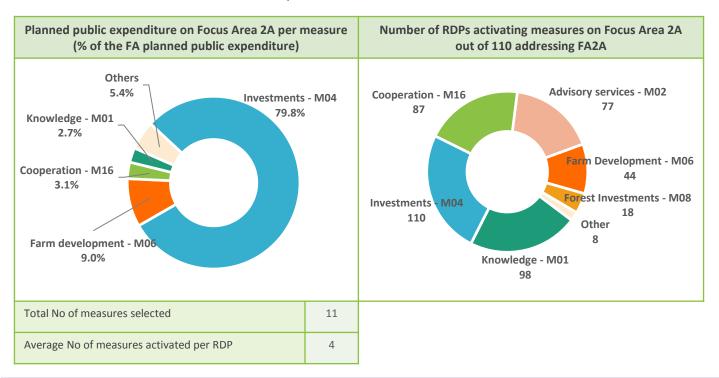

4. Intervention logic at EU level

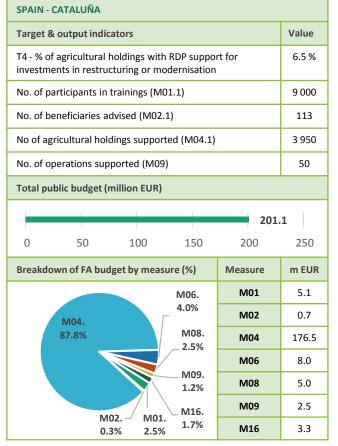
