#### BACKGROUND

The ENRD Evaluation Helpdesk is pleased to invite you to the online Good Practice Workshop, 'A journey through evaluation plans: Learning from past experiences for the future CAP'. The workshop will be conducted as a web-based participatory workshop on 28-29 June 2021.

Given the innovative character of evaluation plans and the experience accumulated since their conception, it is now time to take stock of this experience with the aim to answer some overarching questions:

- What can we learn from the design and implementation of RDP evaluation plans in relation to their scope, evaluation topics and activities proposed and implemented, governance and communication mechanisms?
- To what extent has a strategic approach in planning evaluations improved the quality of evaluation results and their relevance for policy making?
- What constitutes a good approach to planning evaluation activities and what are the attributes of a useful evaluation plan?
- To what extent has the feedback from the activities of evaluation plans been timely for informing future policy making?
- To what extent have the communication activities of evaluation plans contributed to improved dissemination of evaluation results through the evaluation plan's communication mechanisms?

#### OBJECTIVES

The Good Practice Workshop has the overall objective to reflect on experiences in relation to the design and implementation of evaluation plans. In this context the aim will be to:

- Exchange experiences concerning the design and implementation of the Evaluation Plans in order to identify what worked well and what should be avoided.
- Discuss specific elements of the Evaluation Plans in relation to the process, governance, content, management, and communication.
- Identify best practices for the future for further promoting evaluation culture and better design and implementation of the Evaluation Plans.

#### TARGETAUDIENCE

The workshop will be an opportunity to bring together evaluation practitioners like Managing Authorities, Paying Agencies, evaluators, researchers and other evaluation stakeholders in the Member States as well as policy makers to discuss, share concerns and exchange experiences with each other.
