Outputs: NEW DATA FOR MONITORING AND EVALUATION



IMAJINE - Local level database for socio-economic indicators

Potential use in evaluation of the CAP

- Offers data for socio-economic indicators (income, poverty, education, etc.) at local level to measure territorial inequalities.
- Useful for data at the lower spatial level of LAU 2 that is needed for counterfactual analysis of impacts.
- Offers additional indicators, e.g., the level of education, dependency or immigration of the localities, etc. at local level.



The FLINT Farm
Return data recording
system

- Offers data arranged in thematic tables, one of which is 'working conditions and quality of life'.
- Useful for evaluators who want to collect additional data and complement the national/regional FADN sample.

Potential use in evaluation of the CAP

- Can be used to analyse the effects of local development strategies, taking into account poverty, education, economic wealth, unemployment and share of agriculture sector.
- Can help policy makers understand differences at local level.
- Can offer information for policy makers on how to target disadvantaged areas within certain regions.

- Sustainability indicators directly related to policy evaluation: these include social indicators including demographics, quality of life and inclusion issues.
- It is a good start of what social data can be collected for monitoring and how it can be utilised for evaluating the CAP.



- Can be used to analyse the intervention logic of local development strategies






