Programming approach

Option 1

- The measure is addressed to support the creation of partnerships
- The measure covers the coordination and organization costs

Option 2

- The measure is addressed to support the creation of partnerships and the costs arising from project
- The measure covers all costs. The support will be payed as a global amount

Option 3

- Integrated approach, where the measure 16 is addressed to support the creation of partnerships, the projects are supported by the other measures of RDP
- The measure covers the coordination and organization costs. Project costs will be payed by the related measures

Question 1: Financial flow

Application for support



- **The lead-entity** who is presenting to the Paying Agency an «**application for support**», can include in the same application its own cost and also the costs covered by other partners (i.e. plurality of invoices for the same project)?

Question 1: Financial flow Payment

The following cases are
both correct?

CASE 1	
Application for support	Application for Payment
1 application for support	1 application for payment
The Lead-entity is presenting the application for support for the whole project (<u>included its own costs and the costs covered by other partners</u>)	The same Lead-entity is receiving the payment for the overall amount of the project (One single payment that will be <u>later divided among the partners</u>).
CASE 2	
Application for support	Application for Payment
1 application for support	Multiple applications for payment (n. for each partner)
The Lead-entity is presenting the application for support for the whole project (<u>included its own costs and the costs covered by other partners</u>). <i>The application contains a clear indication of cost covered by each partner (amounts in the annex)</i>	The Paying Agency will proceed to pay each of the partners individually (multiple payments).



Question 2: Investment eligibility

- Investments to be financed by M 16 should be clearly identified and demarcated from M 4 investments.

This is relevant both in the case of “*global amount*” and in the case of “*package of measures*” .
